NOTICE

Programs and Services

- The State of Utah complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 by providing services, programs, and activities offered by the State to qualified individuals with disabilities.

Employment

- The State of Utah complies with the ADA by providing employment opportunities to qualified individuals with disabilities.

Prohibitions

- The ADA and Section 504 make it unlawful to discriminate against a qualified individual with a disability. These acts also provide that no qualified individual with a disability shall, by reason of such disability, be excluded from participation in or be subjected to discrimination by any such entity.
