

High School Youth Support Grant

Questions and Answers

We just submitted for the SP 2013. If we don't get SP then our site could be eligible for this HS Support Grant. Is that correct? Will any SP 2013 applications be considered for this HS money? You are correct. If a program does not receive a Safe Passages grant they will be eligible for the High School Grant. They are separate applications so we will not be considering Safe Passages 2013 applications for the High School grant.

You can NOT apply for the HS grant if you have an Aspire Kids grant at the same site? You **may** apply for the HS grant at the same location as ASPIRE Kids as long as it is a separate program and the high school kids are not being used as staff for the elementary program. If you have a Safe Passages grant at a location you may not apply for the HS grant.

We just applied for our Site A and Site B for SP 2013. If we also apply for Site A and Site B for the HS grant, could we withdraw our HS grant application if we were award SP 2013? You are welcome to apply for both. If the SP'13 is award, the High School Youth Support Grant application will automatically be disqualified.

I was able to read through the RFG for the High School Youth Support Grant and would love to approach our XXXXX District High Schools about it but I wanted to know how many schools can apply for it from our district. There is not a limit on how many sites an organization can apply for. Each site will need a separate grant application.

Could we seek funding for a monthly (or bi-monthly) parents workshop? As part of the afterschool program you may provide periodic parent workshops that focus on how the parents can support their teens.

Could we seek funding for background checks for employees? The expense of Background Checks may be paid out of the grant.

Can students receive school credit for attending the afterschool program? Students may work on credit recovery, but not receive credit simply for attending the program.

Can you please define what a licensed educator means and what level of certification does the licensed educator need to have? For the purpose of the grant a Licensed Educator is someone with a current teaching license. The license level does not matter; it can be Level 1-3.
