

Afterschool and Youth

Grant opportunities are available to those organizations with afterschool, before school or summertime programs, serving elementary, middle, junior and high school youth. The focus of the programs must be on a minimum of 2 prevention components: healthy body/lifestyles, financial literacy, healthy human relationships, career exploration, drug and alcohol abuse prevention, and pregnancy and sexually transmitted infection prevention.

Child Care Policy

In an effort to keep families working, the child care assistance program is designed to help subsidize low income families with their child care expenses.

Child Care Resource and Referral

Child Care Resource and Referral assembles and maintains a comprehensive database of child care providers statewide. Parents can obtain free referrals to a provider that best meets their child care needs. The database also contains information regarding local demographics that can be accessed by community organizations or other interested parties.

Professional Development

Low cost training is available statewide to child care providers to enhance their professional development and program quality. The Child Care Professional Development Institute is responsible for processing payments to providers who attend Career Ladder training.

Quality Initiatives

Several quality initiatives are in place to increase the overall quality of child care. Grants may include quality improvement of supplies and environment, and/or quality of staff and training received.
