



## **AIRCRAFT PILOT - FLIGHT ENGINEER**

Pilot and navigate the flight of multi-engine or single-engine aircraft in regularly scheduled or on-demand service for the transport of passengers and cargo. Requires Federal Air Transportation rating and certification in specific aircraft type used (large aircraft–commercial, smaller aircraft–private or recreational). Includes aircraft instructors with similar certification.

**OES - SOC Code: 53-2012** Pilot, Flight Engineer

### **Fees:**

FAA designees, for written and oral flight tests, will charge fees.

Aircraft Pilot certificate does not expire.

Must have FAA class I or class II medical certificate.

Number licensed in Utah is not available.
