



DRIVER - BUS

Bus drivers transport passengers over specified routes, to local or distant points, according to time schedule; assist passengers with baggage and collect tickets or cash fares; regulate heating, lighting, and ventilating systems for passenger comfort. They comply with local traffic regulations, report delays or accidents, record cash receipts and ticket fare. Bus drivers make repairs and change tires; inspect the bus; check the gas, oil, and water before departure; load or unload baggage or express checked by passengers. Transport pupils between pickup points and school.
