Health Care and Social Assistance comprises 10.2 percent of all state employment. It has an average monthly wage of \$3,054, slightly below the state-wide average for all industries.

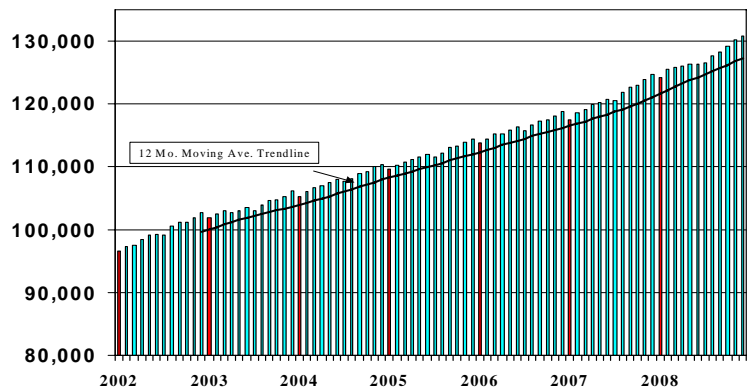
