

The Mining sector comprises only 0.9 percent of all state employment. Much of the employment is spread across the nonmetropolitan portions of the state. It is a sector with many businesses characterized with high wages, as its monthly average of \$5,667 is 86 percent higher than the statewide average for all industries.

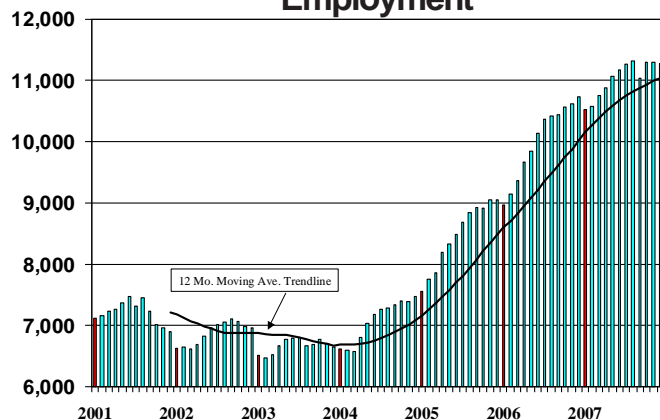
