

Utilities comprise only 0.5 percent of all state employment. It is a sector with businesses characterized with high wages, as its monthly average of \$5,593 is 84 percent higher than the statewide average for all industries. There are a sizeable number of businesses in this classification that are quasi-governmental or government owned.

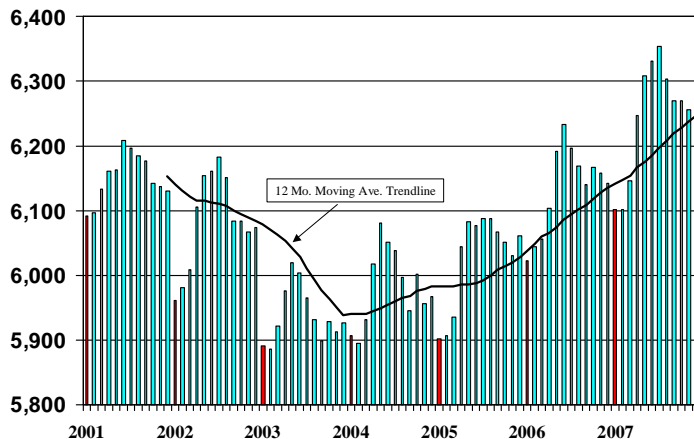
