What is a refugee?

A **refugee** is a person who fled his or her country of origin and is unable to return due to persecution based on religion, race, nationality, political opinion or membership in a particular social group.



why hire a refugee?



How are refugees different than immigrants?

- A **refugee** is legally brought to the United States by the U.S. Department of State.
- They are individuals who may become permanent residents after one year and may apply for citizenship after five years.
- All refugees may legally work in the U.S. as soon as they arrive.
