

# SCHOLARSHIPS FROM UTAH OFFICE OF CHILD CARE and Utah Registry for Professional Development



Office of Child Care (OCC) and the Utah Registry for Professional Development (URPD) provide support for individuals working towards professional development goals in the youth and early childhood education field. Additional temporary scholarships have been made available through COVID-19 stimulus funding.

To be eligible, applicants must be employed for at least 15+ hours a week at a DWS eligible, licensed program.\*
