Request for Grant Application (RFGA)

The State Community Services Office is accepting CSBG Discretionary grant applications to support Utah's nine community action agencies through targeted teaching and technical assistance; support of the community action agencies and their community needs as identified in needs assessments; support of the emergency food needs and resources within the community action agencies' jurisdictions; and network convenings supporting the community action network as well as other interested stake holders. Expertise is required in the CSBG Act, CSBG Organizational Standards, Results Oriented Management and Accountability (ROMA) methodology, tripartite board management, as well as state statute and policies and procedures. Applicants should have good relationships with all nine of Utah's community action agencies and be willing to travel often to provide statewide support. Subcontracting of this funding is not permitted.
