<p>Improving Child Outcomes: Education (Sarah Young, USBE)</p>	<p>a. Access & Technology for Children Experiencing Intergenerational Poverty</p> <p>b. Maintaining Academic Progress for Children Experiencing Intergenerational Poverty in the Wake of Covid-19</p> <p>i. Patty Norman presented on Serving Families, including with devices and broadband efforts.</p> <p>ii. Sarah Young provided the Utah COVID-19 Digital Resources for Broadband: https://docs.google.com/document/d/1n18QDuJFMnZuJzqoLYGWvrB1bjoJMeqkjcCkE8C-H5g/edit?usp=sharing Ms. Young indicated some of the solutions for Utah Broadband including bookmobiles, kiosks, hospital, Community Center for rural Utah Access, expanding access to public networks, public library strategies (hot spot, devices tc), and access points in multi-dwelling units and hotspot bus placements in communities.</p> <p>iii. Ms. Young provided a link for tableau data dashboard which demonstrates challenges facing statewide, including San Juan Area; https://public.tableau.com/profile/allison.shrivastava#!/vizhome/broadbandpresentaiton/broadbanddashboard Robert Palmer indicated in August USBE will release the next cohort of funding for the IGP after school grant and provided an update on the examples of after school grantees supporting students during COVID-19. The Commission and Advisory Committee discussed next steps including how UPSTART has worked closely with Ms. Young on getting children connected and those who are currently participating in program have access to a device & internet. Mr. Pierpont inquired about strategies to prioritize IGP students to ensure these children don't fall further behind. Ms. Young explained that is within 10.8% without broadband and will have more flushed out proposal within the next 2 weeks. 	<p>Ben Gibbs interested to know if data collection effort to demonstrate impact of expanding broadband. Ms. Young stated inventory was in infrastructure. Utah School 2019 Technology Inventory Report: https://www.uen.org/digitallearning/downloads/2019Inventory/UtahSchoolTechnologyInventory.pdf</p> <p>CARES dollars can be used, but this is a need that extends beyond CARES and Covid-19. Want to establish this as a continuing investment, rather than a one-time payment. This needs to continue to exist, post the Covid-19 pandemic.</p>	
Research Agenda (Tracy Gruber)	<p>a. 2020 Annual Report Timeline and Structure. The report is data from a year ago, not current data. Research subcommittee meets regularly and is set to be released by October 1, 2020. New timeline for longitudinal study is for those studies to come back and be reviewed by Committee in September, so can be released a little after 2020 Annual report.</p> <p>b. Evaluating Family Outcomes through Two Models: Circles and ICAN (Weber County). Ms. Gruber explained the Legislature appropriated funding to counties to address IGP. A couple Counties implementing two different models; Circles and ICAN. Finally at a point in the work, to potentially see outcomes and compare the different outcomes.</p>
