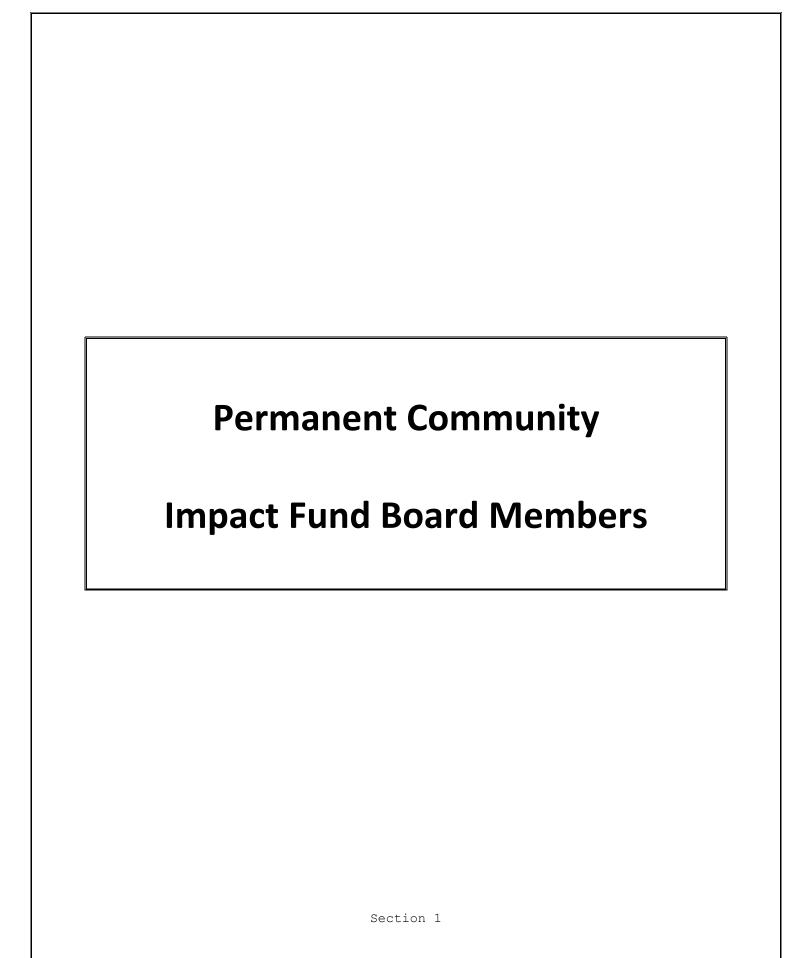

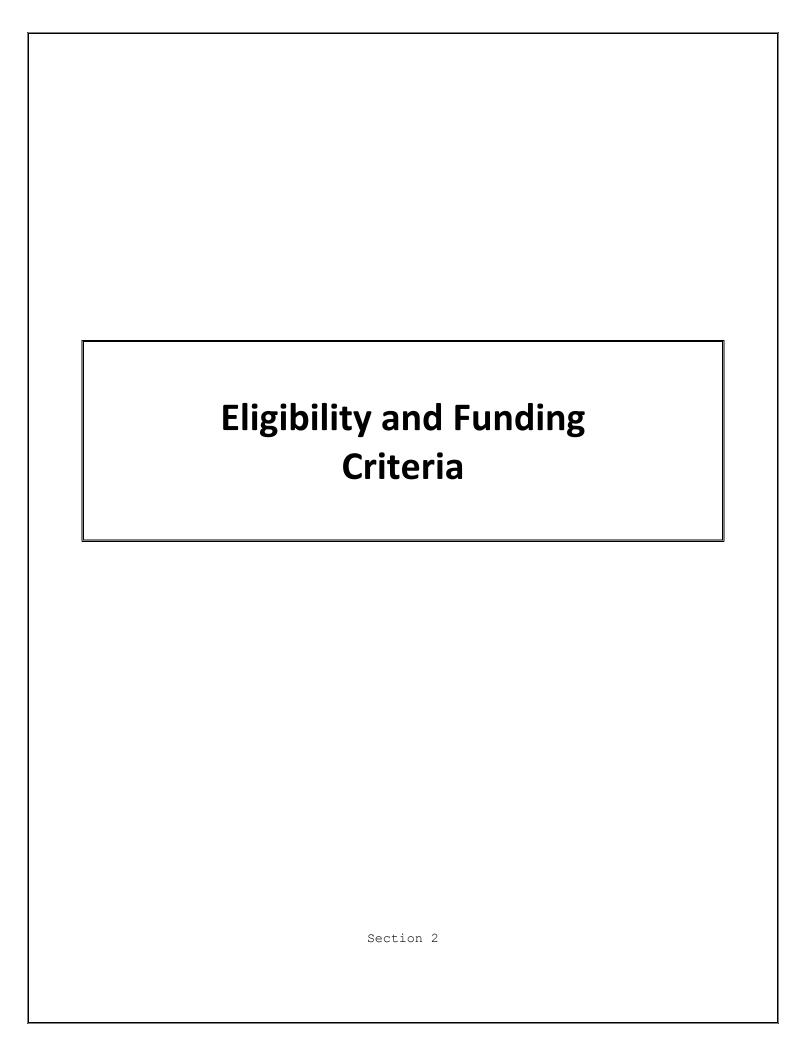

PERMANENT COMMUNITY IMPACT FUND BOARD GRANT & LOAN PROGRAM

Statutory Authority

The Permanent Community Impact Fund Board (CIB) is a program of the State of Utah authorized in Section 35A-8-301, et seq. The goal of the CIB is to maximize the long-term benefit of funds derived from these lease revenues and bonus payments by fostering funding mechanisms which will, consistent with sound financial practices, result in the greatest use of financial resources for the greatest number of citizens of this state, with priority given to those communities designated as impacted by the development of natural resources covered by the Mineral Leasing Act. The CIB's source of funding is a portion of federal mineral lease royalties returned to the State by the Federal Government. Board Membership

The CIB is controlled by an eleven-member Board composed of:

- the state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee;
- the chair of the Transportation Commission or the chair's designee;
- the executive director of the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget or the executive director's designee;
- a locally elected official who resides in Carbon, Emery, Grand, or San Juan County;
- a locally elected official who resides in Juab, Millard, Sanpete, Sevier, Piute, or Wayne County;
- a locally elected official who resides in Duchesne, Daggett, or Uintah County;
- a locally elected official who resides in Beaver, Iron, Washington, Garfield, or Kane County;
- a locally elected official from the county that produced the most mineral lease money related to oil
 extraction during the four-year period immediately preceding the term of appointment, as determined by
 the department at the end of each term; and does not already have a representative on the impact
 board:
- a locally elected official from the county that produced the most mineral lease money related to natural
 gas extraction during the four-year period immediately preceding the term of appointment, as determined
 by the department at the end of each term and does not already have a representative on the impact
 board;
- a locally elected official from the county that produced the most mineral lease money related to coal
 extraction during the four-year period immediately preceding the term of appointment, as determined by
 the department at the end of each term and does not already have a representative on the impact board;
- an individual who resides in a county of the third, fourth, fifth, or sixth class, appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the Senate which is the *Chairman*.

Administrative and operational support is provided by the state Housing and Community Development Division.

Eligible Applicants

- "Eligible Applicants" are limited to Utah state agencies and "subdivision of the state" including; counties, cities, towns, county service areas, special service districts, special improvement districts, water conservancy districts, water or sewer improvement districts, building authorities, school districts, and public postsecondary institutions.
- "Ineligible Applicants" include Indian Tribes, individuals, corporations, associations, private non-profit groups.
- Eligible applicants cannot apply on behalf of ineligible applicants.

Eligible Projects

- Utah state statute authorizes the CIB to fund the following types of activities: planning, construction and maintenance of public facilities, and provision of public services within the State of Utah.
- The CIB's administrative rules further define "public facilities and services" to mean public infrastructure traditionally provided by governmental entities.
- Eligibility is limited to projects owned by an eligible applicant.

Funding Guidelines

- Planning & study funding requests require a fifty percent cash contribution from the applicant.
- Funding requests for municipal planning and studies under \$50,000 are reviewed and authorized for funding by the Utah Community Development Office staff on an expedited basis.
- In-kind funds must have a demonstrable value, such as real property.
- Projects deemed more essential to the health, safety, and welfare of a community will be considered to receive better funding terms, including a greater proportion of grant in the funding package.
- The estimated longevity of the project and loan financing will not extend past the useful life of the project.
- Revenue sources have inherent restrictions. B&C road revenues cannot be pledged in excess of 10 years and mineral lease revenues cannot exceed 15 years.
- Applicants must provide evidence and arguments to the Board as to how the proposed funding
 assistance provides for planning, the construction and maintenance of public facilities or the provision of
 public services.
- The CIB Application must identify how the project alleviates impacts on public infrastructure, public finance, federal land, employment and safety.
- State Procurement Standards must be followed across all projects funded by CIB.
- Solid waste management projects will be funded only with interest bearing loans.
- Applicants cannot count the use of in-kind funds unless the in-kind participation has a demonstrable value, such as real property. Donated labor or staff time cannot be counted as in-kind.
- The applicant shall submit a copy of any proposed application to the State History Preservation Officer (SHPO) for review and comment regarding the effect of the proposed project will have on any district, site, building structure or specimen that is included in or eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places or the State Register. https://heritage.utah.gov/history/compliance-historic-structures

Funding Process

The CIB reviews applications and authorizes funding assistance on a Trimester basis during the state fiscal year (July 1st – June 30th).

Meetings are held the first Thursday of each month. The initial meetings of each Trimester are Project Review Meetings. The final meeting of each Trimester" is the Funding Meeting.
