Throughput Infrastructure Funding Recommendation Checklist

Entities applying to receive funding must generally satisfy the following requirements as a precondition to the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board / Throughput Infrastructure Fund issuing a funding award. Not all requirements will apply to all projects.

Definition (Statement of Work)

- Scope: Objectives, rationale, benefits, description of work to be performed
- Schedule: Timing of steps and project milestones
- Budget: Budgets by project milestone and cost category, with documented assumptions
- Special Conditions: Specific requirements applicable to this project (e.g. project milestones, CIB approvals, reporting requirements, etc.)

Financials

- Operating Financials: Revenue projections; operating and maintenance costs
- Capital Program: Capital plan for infrastructure
- Financing Approach: Financial condition, capital sources (including for cost overruns), and annual operating sources

Delivery

- Risk Management Approach: Identified risks and mitigation strategies
- Management Capability & Approach: Plan for management structure of project, including organizational charts and staffing plans
- Project Implementation & Procurement Approach: Description of project delivery method, including information on procurement and compliance
- Safety and Security Approach: Consideration of safety and security concerns and approaches for both construction and
 operations

Agreements

- Project Agreements: Legal agreements with all applicable entities, with details on engineering, statement of work, construction, service outcomes, cost sharing, and any other relevant issues
- · Service Operator Agreements: Commitments and concurrences from the entities that will benefit from the project
- Other Agreements: Other agreements as necessitated by specific project conditions, such as with real estate owners, utilities, other states, local governments, etc.

Prerequisites

- Engineering Documentation: Conceptual engineering, preliminary engineering, final design
- Environmental Documentation: Service NEPA (P-EIS, P-EA) and/or Project NEPA (EIS, EA, CE) as necessary.
- Project Development Plan: Proposed characteristics of project
- **Public Participation:** Demonstrated compliance with R990-008-3(E)-(F)
- Legal Compliance: Applicants must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws.
