Eligible applicants include emergency food pantries, prepared meal sites, and other agencies whose mission is to meet emergency food needs for low income Utah residents. Applications will be evaluated based upon alignment with any or all of the following program goals and objectives.

- Making emergency food facilities safe and accessible low-income Utahans
- Increasing participation in the food stamp program
- Providing case management and referrals to help recipients become self-reliant
- Coordination with other emergency food providers
