Your military experience can help you find employment.

Your VMET Report

The Verification of Military Experience and Training (VMET) report provides a record of your military experience and training while on active duty and can assist in obtaining employment.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Service in the Army, Navy, Air Force, or Marines (Coast Guard information is not in the VMET system) AND
- Service on or after, October 1, 1990

Requesting a report

1. Common Access Card (CAC)

The CAC is a U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) smart card issued as standard identification for:

- Active duty military personnel
- Eligible contractor personnel
- State employees of the National Guard
- Other non-DoD government employees
- Reserve personnel
- Civilian employees

2. DS Logon, Level 2

This allows beneficiaries affiliated with the DoD or the VA to access several websites using a single username and password. The DS logon provides a high level of authentication assurance in situations where the CAC authentication is not available.
