New Utah Refugee Center Location

On November 16, the Utah Refugee Center moved to a new state-owned location at 150 N. 1950 W. in Salt Lake City (formerly the SLEC). It is conveniently situated near the state's refugee resettlement agencies and across from a TRAX stop (the 1940 W. North Temple Station) so customers can easily access the Center. All Refugee Services staff (including the team formerly working from Metro) are now at the new location.

The Utah Refugee Center will continue to offer Utah's refugees access to employment services, training and a place for connection. The new location is more affordable, ensuring partners, refugee communities and customers have access to the space needed.

Refugee Services staff are following guidelines tied to the state's COVID-19 Transmission Index. People should call before coming to the Center (801-618-5096, Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.).
