

SCHOLARSHIPS FROM UTAH OFFICE OF CHILD CARE



and Utah Registry for Professional Development

Office of Child Care (OCC) and the Utah Registry for Professional Development (URPD) provide support for individuals working towards professional development goals in the youth and early childhood education field.

CDA scholarships are open to all applicants who work 15+ hours a week in any program that cares for children 0-12 in Utah:

Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential (Infant/Toddler, Preschool or Family Child Care)	\$525
CDA Renewal (Infant/Toddler, Preschool or Family Child Care)	\$250

To be eligible for the following scholarships, applicants must be employed for at least 15+ hours a week at a DWS eligible, licensed program:

Certified Childcare Professional (CCP)	\$350
CCP Renewal	\$50
National Administrator's Credential (NAC)	Maximum of \$650
NAC Renewal	\$60
Demonstrated Competency Observation Fee by URPD Approved Observer (paid directly to the observer)	Maximum of \$100
