

## How to Obtain Amplified Phones and Assistive Technology:

The Sanderson Center of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing offers a free demonstration technology lab where people can come to learn and try assistive devices before they buy. Individuals can try the phones, compare features and amplification strength, and even borrow our phones or other assistive technology for a week or so to try in their home environment to ensure their satisfaction with their choice before they buy. The Sanderson Center does not sell the phones, but offers assistance for individuals to learn what is available, provides free classes on the listener, speaker and environmental impacts to communication breakdowns and the simple steps one can take to reduce communication breakdowns inherent with hearing loss.

Also, individuals who are on Medicaid, other income-based support programs, and some life-saving alerting devices, are automatically eligible to receive a free amplified phone or other loaner device from the Relay Utah program (visit [www.relayutah.org](http://www.relayutah.org) for full eligibility criteria, the application and equipment available). Individuals on Medicare do not qualify at this time. Individuals, who do not qualify, are not eligible for Vocational Rehabilitation services (visit [www.usor.utah.gov](http://www.usor.utah.gov)), would have to purchase their own device or seek support from charity organizations.
