




### Year-Over Change in NonFarm Jobs




### Salt Lake County Year-Over Job Change September 2013



### Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rates




### Percent Change in Nonfarm Jobs by Industry September 2012 – September 2013




Percent Change in Total Permit-Authorized Construction Values





4-Week Moving Average of Initial Unemployment Claims




Year-Over Change in Gross Taxable Sales


4th Quarter Average Weekly Initial Claims
