## Services Provided

- Job searching assistance and resources for job skills development
- Post-secondary education preparation and training assistance
- High school diploma activities and dropout recovery services with connection through adult education, tutoring and other basic education services
- Connection to mentoring, individual counseling and leadership development activities
- Work experience opportunities and connection to labor market information
- Referrals to community resources and agencies, including Vocational Rehabilitation for customers with disabilities
- Budgeting and financial assistance through workshops and resources



## Eligibility Criteria

- Be between the ages of 14 and 24
- Verify citizenship or eligibility to work in the U.S.
- Meet the WIOA Youth criteria and income guidelines
- Complete a basic skills assessment
- Have a desire to succeed and be willing to apply yourself

## Referral Process

- Sign in to “my Job Search” or create a new job search account at <http://jobs.utah.gov/>
- Click on “Apply for Training Services”
- Complete the application for training
- Once completed, a DWS representative will call within 3 days to schedule an appointment
