Whereas, the Community Development Block Grant Program has been operating in Utah for 40 years to support community development activities that build stronger and more resilient communities;

Whereas, the Community Development Block Grant Program is among the few remaining federal programs available to address the needs of low and moderate-income individuals, families, and small cities in rural areas;

Whereas, the Community Development Block Grant Program has provided \$259,780,242 to fund 2,695 projects in small cities in Utah since 1982;

Whereas, the Community Development Block Grant Program has provided the state of Utah with important and flexible assistance to meet the needs of low and moderate-income residents of small cities by funding sewer, water, street improvements projects, and other public improvement projects; and,

Whereas, Congress and the nation acknowledge the critical value of the Community Development Block Grant Program and the significant projects that rely on its funds for support;
