



## Program Administrators, Owners and Directors Application Checklist to Help Your Staff



| Ensure your program has an active, eligible license (or regulation) type and Facility ID # from Child Care Licensing (Help)   |
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| Ensure your staff information is up-to-date in the Child Care Licensing Provider Portal, including disassociating former employees and assigning correct roles to all current staff. (Help)   |
| Help your staff access their Child Care Licensing Background Check<br>Number. ( <u>Help</u> )   |
| Ensure staff are registered as individual users within the Care About Childcare website, <u>cac.utah.gov</u> ( <u>Help</u> ), and their profiles are connected to your program on the "Staff" (Center-based) or "Caregivers" (Family-based) page. (The magnifying glass will be visible in the grid next to their name if their profile is linked.) |
| Help your staff access their pay stubs or fill out the <u>Employment</u> <u>Verification Form</u> .   |
