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



- The Child Development Associate (CDA)
 Credential™ is the most widely recognized credential in early childhood education (ECE) and is a key stepping stone on the path of career advancement in ECE.
- Cohorts are offered each year by CAC agencies to support you within a group of peers.
- CDA Scholarship now available to all!

Eligible professionals working in licensed programs may apply for an incentive when they complete a new level on the Career Ladder. For a limited time \$250 will be added to each level awarded. The bonus will end on May 31, 2024!




